Q. You were playing with Austin and Amy, who were playing really well, as well. Does that help you maybe?

ANGEL YIN: Yeah, we kind of feed off each other. They make a birdie on this hole, we make a birdie on the next hole, so every hole we kind of birdied, too. Especially Amy; Amy played really well today. I'm going to be playing with her tomorrow, so that's going to be fun. It's our second week paired together.

Q. Do you like that?

ANGEL YIN: Yeah, I do. I think we should be paired together for the rest of the year.

Q. How is the golf course playing now that the wind is picking up?

ANGEL YIN: More difficult. The greens are firmer, and it's just going to be more challenging. I thought the wind was going to be -- was going to be blowing
